Conditions for using the Wilson Wang Water Sports Centre (2023)

Registration & Membership

- 1. Registered users may use St Stephen's College Swimming Pool and its car park at the Wilson Wang Water Centre during opening hours.
- 2. Users **must** present their user cards / staff cards for admission to the facilities and should produce their cards on demand by College personnel. The College personnel may request visitors to show their HKID card for verification if the membership card does not bear a photo.
- 3. Registration of the user is subject to the approval of the College. The user card is not transferable and registration fee paid is not refundable.
- 4. If a user card is lost or stolen, the user concerned shall notify the College immediately by telephone and confirm the loss in writing as soon as possible. A duplicate may be issued to replace a lost card at a fee of \$25.
- 5. User cards remain the property of the College and registration may be revoked by the College at any time without prior notice.
- 6. Only users' vehicles with car park labels properly displayed on the windscreens may use the Swimming Pool car park free during the opening hours of the Swimming Pool on a first-come-first-served basis. When the car park is full, the gate will be closed.
- 7. All cars must be parked as directed by the College personnel.
- 8. Validity of user card automatically expires on 31 October 2022. The membership will cease once the user is no longer a member of the College / Preparatory School and all family membership card(s) should also be returned to the College / Preparatory School.
- 9. Membership of Primary 6 and Secondary 6 students automatically expires on the last day of the school year, that is, 31st August 2022 while that of all other students expires on 31st October, 2022. The membership will cease once the student withdraws from the College or the Preparatory School.
- 10. User should go through a temperature check before entering the Swimming Pool area, any user who has a body temperature higher than 37.2 °C are not allowed to enter the pool area.
- 11. For persons aged 65 or above and aged 15 or below, persons with disability and other persons recognized by the Government or organization(s) authorized by the Government as eligible for the above arrangement, he / she needs to fill in a specified form as an alternative.

General Rules

- 12. Users using the Swimming Pool should change in the changing rooms and are required to adopt a dress standard that will not offend others.
- 13. Users should take care when walking on wet floors in the Swimming Pool area.
- 14. Only swimmers in appropriate swimming costumes and persons authorized by the College are permitted in the pool side area.
- 15. Children under the age of 12 are required to be carefully supervised by a parent / guardian when they are using pool facilities.
- 16. Before entering the pool and the pool side areas, all swimmers must shower themselves thoroughly and wash their feet in the footbath.
- 17. No person suffering from any infectious or communicable disease is allowed to enter the pool.
- 18. While using the pool, persons with long hair must wear swimming caps to avoid blockage of the filtration plant by loose long hair. For the purpose of this rule, shoulder length hair is interpreted as long.
- 19. No person wearing footwear of any description, except clean and unsoiled rubber / plastic flip-flops, shall enter the pool side areas. Rubber / plastic flip-flops, if worn, must be washed in the footbath.
- 20. Jumping into the pool is not allowed. Games and aids which may cause hindrance to other swimmers are prohibited in the pool and pool side areas.
- 21. No person using the Swimming Pool is allowed to use suntan lotion.
- 22. No eating, smoking, drinking or carrying of glasses or bottles is allowed within the pool area.
- 23. No pets are allowed in the pool area.
- 24. No audio-visual or musical equipment may be used in the vicinity of the swimming pool except with personal earphones.
- 25. No photo taking activities and video recording are allowed without the approval of the College.
- 26. No unauthorized coaching is permitted at the pool.
- 27. The use of breakable and easily chipped swimming aids is not allowed in the pool.
- 28. No display of and / or distribution of posters and publicity materials are allowed unless prior permission is obtained from the Principal or Deputy Principal.
- 29. Promotion or displaying of posters, banners or any means of propaganda of any political views, messages or stands within the pool area are not allowed.
- 30. All users shall observe all regulations regarding the use of the facilities and the instructions given by the College personnel.
- 31. All users shall abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Swimming Pool and all Hong Kong Laws. Users will be asked to leave the pool area immediately in case of any acts or speech that violate the Rules and Regulations of the Swimming Pool and the Hong Kong Laws. All fees and charges paid will not be refunded.

Closure of Swimming Pool

- 32. The College has the right to close the Swimming Pool / car park without prior notice in the event of adverse weather conditions or for school functions.
- 33. All users of the pool must leave the pool area at the end of each session at the sound of a bell (15 minutes before the Swimming Pool closing time).
- 34. When the number of users at the pool areas reaches the permissible limit, the pool personnel are authorized to close the entrance gate temporarily.

Liability

- 35. The College and the Preparatory School are not liable for any damage to or loss of property of the users.
- 36. The College and the Preparatory School are not liable for death or personal injury occurring in the Wilson Wang Water Sports Centre.
- 37. The College reserves the rights to amend or modify the conditions of using the Wilson Wang Water Sports Center at any time and any such change will become effective upon notification to members by any means the College deems fit.

D. Closure of Swimming Pool due to Adverse Weather Conditions

1. The swimming pool will not open to swimmers when

- (1) typhoon signal no. 3 or above is hoisted, or
- (2) amber, red or black rainstorm signals is issued, or
- (3) the thunderstorm warning is issued during times when in use.

2. The Swimming Pool will reopen to swimmer (if facilities and the swimming pool conditions are satisfactory) when

- (1) **3 hours** after the typhoon signal no. 3 is lowered (If the typhoon signal no. 3 is lowered less than 3 hours before the closing time, the swimming pool will not reopen on that day.)
- (2) **1 hour** after all rainstorm signal is lowered (If the rainstorm signal is lowered less than 1 hour before the closing time, the swimming pool will not reopen on that day.)
- (3) **as soon as** the thunderstorm warning is cancelled.
